Teams

- 4 Members per team. 24 participant limit in Children's division. (Children's division will be split into smaller age groups after all entries are received.)
- TEAM LIMIT – 40
- Each participant will only be allowed to wrestle ONCE
- Each team must have a team name. Be creative, no swear words.
- A limited number of teams will be accepted in each category with a "first come first served" policy on entries.

- **Entries must be turned in to the Fair office by Friday, July 15th.** Late entries will be accepted if additional spots are available with a \$15 late fee.
- Entry form must be complete with entry fee, team name and team members' names. All entrants must sign waiver. (Entry form and full payment must be received for entry consideration.)
- Contestants under 18 years of age **MUST** have release form signed by parent or guardian

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Rules

IMPORTANT INFORMATION!

- 4 members per team
- 1 minute time limit to catch pig and put on pad
- Placing is determined by wrestling time.
- Junior and High School categories may be co-ed.
- Sponsor or team captain is responsible for the actions of the team
- Only team members allowed in the event area. (Children and Juniors may be accompanied by a parent/guardian)
- Check-In Time – The team check-in time is between 5:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m., Friday, July 29, 2010
The teams will check in at the South end of the rodeo arena, near the “crows nest”
- The team meeting will be held at 5:30 p.m. in the bleachers by the “ring”. If the team is not at the meeting, it will be a forfeit.
- Rules will be announced before event
- Order will be drawn prior to competition.
- Team must catch and place hog on barrel with bare hands in one (1) minute or less. The pig’s ears, snout, and tail are off limits. ABSOLUTELY NO abuse or roughing of the pig will be tolerated. Time will be stopped if the judge feels the pig is in trouble or is being mishandled and the team will be disqualified.
- **NO ARTIFICIAL CATCH DEVICES. UNNECESSARY CRUELTY WILL DISQUALIFY TEAM.** (ie. hitting, kicking, stunning the animal is strictly prohibited)
- All players must start with one hand on the starting fence
 - The pig handler will release the pig into the ring
 - The timer will blow the whistle to signify when the team can start
- Committee will open gate for hog to jump into arena. When all four legs of the hog are in the mud, the starter will signal. At the sound of the whistle, teams will enter the ring. Flagger will signal time to start. When the hog is placed on the barrel and the team raises their arms straight up, the clock will stop. Each member of the team must have one hand on the pig as it goes on the barrel.
- Committee will advance the hog into the ring, at the sound of the horn contestants will enter the ring. The clock starts when the first contestant breaks the barrier and official raises the flag. Clock stops when the hog is placed on top of the barrel and the official raises the flag.
- Barrel must be upright at all times.
- Teams must have the hog in the chute after each run or they will be disqualified.
- Judges, timer, starter, flagger and gate person – **ALL DECISIONS FINAL.**
- Please dress for mud!
- Shoes must be worn at all times inside the arena, (no thong sandals). NO CLEATS ALLOWED
- This is a family event, so please dress appropriately. (ie. Undergarmets required, no white t-shirts for females, no swimming suits, etc.)
- For the safety of all, all loose articles must be removed before entering arena.
- A wash station will be available for clean-up
- Participants are not allowed in the building facilities until they are cleaned-up

PARTICIPANTS MUST USE WASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED BY THE FAIR BOARD AT THE ARENA. (BRING A CHANGE OF CLOTHES)

NO ONE ALLOWED IN OTHER AREAS OF THE FAIR WITH WET CLOTHES. NO MUD ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF ARENA. FAIR BUILDING AND EXHIBIT BUILDING BATHROOMS ARE NOT TO BE USED FOR CLEAN UP.

NO MUD SLINGING INSIDE OR OUTSIDE OF ARENA. HOG WRESTLING PARTICIPANTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE GRANDSTANDS OR RESTROOMS IN THE BUILDINGS UNLESS PARTICIPANTS ARE CLEANED UP OR THEY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND BARRED FROM PARTICIPATING IN FUTURE COMPETITIONS.

Release Form

I, the undersigned Participant (parent/Guardian must sign if a child under the age of 18 years is being registered), expressly waive, relinquish and discharge the Canyon County Fair and Canyon County, their officials, officers, employees, agents and any other natural person associated with such entities (herein collectively called the "COUNTY") from all claims and causes of action that the undersigned ever had, now unanticipated, that the undersigned or any person claiming through me may have or claim to have against the COUNTY created by, arising from, related to, or in any way connected with the participation or involvement of the Participant in the above-described program or activity.
