4. All articles must be the handwork of the exhibitor.
5. No flower designs may be created on the premises. A table will be available for minor adjustments prior to entry.
6. No artificial flowers or foliage are permitted. Only dried material may be painted or dyed; fresh materials may not be altered.
7. All containers and vases must be marked on the underside with the exhibitor's name. The Canyon County Fair is not responsible for lost or broken containers.
8. Accessories may be used but must be securely attached.
9. To improve appearance of the flower show, the Superintendent reserves the right to discard wilted materials and replace them with fresh materials when possible.
10. Entries may be moved by the Superintendent to improve display appearance. Boxes, containers, and extra bottles used for transport must be removed from the building after entries are placed.
